



# SOLICITOR'S STAMPS UNDER THE LEGAL PROFESSION UNIFORM LAW

With the commencement of the Uniform Law on 1 July 2015, all solicitors will need to update their solicitor stamps to take into account the new legislative regime.

Stamps should include the following wording:

**The practitioners name and address, followed by:**

**An Australian legal practitioner within the meaning of the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW).**

When the Uniform Law commences, any practitioner who is utilising existing stamps (pending the issue of new stamps), should cross out and initial the words Legal Profession Act 2004 and replace with the words:

**An Australian legal practitioner within the meaning of the Legal Profession Uniform Law (NSW).**
