Don't get caught out! Complexities in the PPSA

Any practitioner that deals with security interests regularly knows that the regime prescribed by the *Personal Property Securities Act 2009* (Cth) is highly complex. As lawyers, we are responsible for ensuring registrations are valid and effective.
