Meet the speaker

The Honourable Justice Peter Campton, Federal Circuit and Family Court of Australia

Justice Campton completed a Bachelor of Laws at the University of Sydney in 1983 and was admitted as a Solicitor in the Supreme Court of New South Wales in 1984. His Honour commenced practice at Huxedurp Jessop and Brewer in Blacktown and in early 1985 joined Smythe & Mallam at St Marys, where he became a partner in 1988. From 1995 His Honour practised from the 'Jewel of the West' (Parramatta in Sydney) as an Accredited Specialist in Family Law. His Honour was called to the New South Wales Bar in February 2000, joining Arthur Phillip Chambers in Parramatta. He established Waratah Chambers in Sydney with Peter Batey and Michael Kearney SC in 2007, and was appointed Senior Counsel in October 2014. His Honour practised exclusively in the area of family law, including complex financial and high-risk parenting disputes.
